





WASHINGTON AVENUE & 11TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Road Construction Report

AUGUST 2024



On Monday, June 3, phased construction of the Washington Ave and Manette Bridge roundabout started with work during the month of June and July focused on the northeast and southeast corners of the intersection. To minimize construction impact to the traveling public, construction of the roundabout will occur in 3 phases with an estimated completion in August 2024.

Starting on or around Monday, July 29, the final phase of roundabout construction will begin and work will move to the center of the intersection. Due to the required work area, traffic will not be permitted to travel through the intersection, but vehicles will be permitted to make right-turns at the intersection if approaching from the Manette Bridge or downtown. 11th St and Washington Ave (north of the Manette Bridge) will be temporarily closed to thru traffic. Signed detours will be in place and local access along the project will be maintained. This work is currently anticipated to take 3 weeks to complete.

We ask all drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists to stay aware in the work area and obey all posted signs. We understand that temporary closures and detours can be inconvenient, but they are provided for your safety and to minimize the need for much more significant closures.

Road Construction Report


AUGUST 2024

The exhibits below include anticipated work areas including impacts to traffic. Exhibits are informational and subject to change based on unforeseen conditions which may occur through the remainder of construction. There are currently no anticipated weekday or weekend closures of the Manette Bridge to traffic for construction activities.

ROUNABOUT CONSTRUCTION (PHASE 3)

Beginning Monday, July 29 final roundabout construction will occur at Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge. The expected duration of this work is approximately 3 weeks subject to change based on weather and unforeseen conditions.



DETOURS AND CLOSURES: This work will require a detour of northbound Washington Ave traffic and eastbound 11th St traffic as depicted above. Local access from 11th St and Washington Ave will be maintained during this work. Thru traffic should expect minor delays during this work and seek alternative routes if possible.

TRAFFIC CHANGES: The intersection of Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge will be signed to only permit right-turns from Washington Ave northbound and the Manette Bridge westbound. Narrowing of traffic lanes will be required. Over-sized vehicles should use alternate routing via Warren Ave (SR 303). Daytime intermittent flagging and holding of traffic at the intersection may be required during weekday work hours.

PEDESTRIANS: Temporary crosswalks will be provided near Washington Ave and the Manette Bridge to provide pedestrian access around the work area. Pedestrian detour routes will be signed. The sidewalk along the Manette Bridge will remain open.

CYCLIST: Portions of existing bike lanes near the work area may be temporarily impacted. Bike lanes on southbound Washington Ave between the Manette Bridge and 6th St will be closed - Cyclist are encouraged to walk bicycles along the existing northbound Washington Ave sidewalk or follow the posted detour.

PARKING: Impacts to existing on-street parking are not anticipated. Any necessary temporary parking restrictions will be signed.
