The Need to Know Right Now:

Date: Saturday May 15th, 5PM until Sunday May 16th after the outdoor services (about 10:15AM)

GUARDIANS-- your role:

Saturday: Help your kiddos set up their camp site between 5 and 545pm. Be present for Camping orientation at 545pm.
6pm: Go home and party like it's 1999 (remember, pre-children?)

Sunday: join your kiddos for camp tear down (if they'll need your help)- 8:30am
outdoor church at 930am; BTW- you do have to take them home afterwards, we're not keeping them

You must:

RSVP by May 12th at 5pm

Commit to having FUN in the great outdoors

Wear a Face Mask (the more fun the better!)

Be COVID symptom free and agree to follow social distancing requests/requirements

FAQs:

What if I need to go potty??

Not to worry, we'll all need to at some point! The Church will be open for bathroom facilities throughout the event. No latrines for this adventure!

What if I don't have a tent/camping gear??

No problem! Just let us know when you RSVP so we can loan you supplies.

Can I share a tent with my friends?

Tent shares will be coordinated with your RSVP. Guardians must give permission for non-family members to tent share with others. Each Tent will be socially distanced from the next so that masks do not need to be worn inside your tent's area.

Do I really have to wear a mask?

Yes...we know you're sick of them. We are too. But, we're going with maximum coverage and minimal risk here. Masks must be worn for all activities when not in your tent area or eating. Your Dynamic Duo will review mask expectations at the beginning of the night with camp orientation.

What do I bring to a Lock Out?

Not to worry, Julie loves lists! And she'll provide you with a full list of supplies to bring closer to the date. For now, just commit to the event and let her know if you need a tent!

What if it rains?

A little rain didn't stop Noah, did it? OK, we don't have an ark, so we'll see how serious the rain might be and make a call as the date/time gets closer.

Lock Out Things To Look Forward To:

games (duh!), scavenger hunt, some physical activities

we might even have an outdoor movie screen and fire pit!

Competitions: tent sites, masks, and more!

Packing List: (not the final one, but can help folks start thinking)

tent

sleeping bag, blankets, pillow, or whatever you want to make the ground sleep-able for you
tennis shoes (for hiking, fitness)

chair and/or blanket for outside (beach towels work great too)

flashlight

something comfy to sleep in

bug spray/sun block if desired

your favorite late night or movie snack to share (individually wrapped items)

water bottle

whatever you want to wear to outdoor church service

toothbrush/toothpaste

personal toiletries if needed

face mask

layers (it could be chilly after sunset)

charger for your phone (we will allow youth to charge phones in the church overnight if desired)

Best tent site: you **and your family** can decorate it from 5pm-545pm. Be creative. Any theme, any decorations, no limits- as long as it fits in your space! Special judging to occur!

Best face mask: 3 categories: hand-made (by you), funny, fancy
