I am proud to announce the School District of the City of York has been awarded a \$3,385,636 grant from the state to cover the costs of remediating the district's <u>school buildings</u> and make them safer.

The money will be used to fix environmental hazards, including the elimination of any lead, mold, and asbestos; and to repair and replace heaters and air conditioners where needed. It comes from the state's <a href="Public School Environmental Repairs Program">Public School Environmental Repairs Program</a>, under funding approved by the legislature in the 2023-24 state budget.

**Program Reminders** 



We have heard from DHS, as well as constituents, that EBT scammers have been skimming SNAP benefits at extremely high rates. If you believe you have been the victim of such a scam, please reach out to your local County Assistance Office. My District Office has the form to report skimmed EBT cards, which we can submit to the Department of Human Services. However, you choose to submit this information, take these steps as soon as you are able to! The quicker you report it, the quicker you can get re-issued a new card, and the quicker your benefits can be re-issued to you!

PLEASE NOTE: There is misinformation that my District Office now handles Food Stamps reimbursement, we do not. As always, the

Department of Human Services and your County Assistance Offices oversee EBT/SNAP benefits. Our office can simply submit an inquiry on your behalf in the event of questions, concerns, and special circumstances regarding your benefits. If you have any question or require assistance, please contact my office at 717.848.9595

Again, We DO NOT reinstate SNAP benefits in my office.

# HISPANIC HERITAGE FILM SERIES CICLO DE CINE DE HERENCIA HISPANA


Each FREE film will open with remarks by its curator, a York County community member, detailing why they think the movie should be shared and how it has impacted them.
