BACKGROUND

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act was signed into law. It is a \$1.9 trillion package of assistance measures, including \$2.75 billion for the American Rescue Plan's Emergency Assistance to Nonpublic Schools (ARP EANS) program. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) administered the EANS II program with these funds. Per federal statute, unspent funds revert to the Governor for redirection. Governor Parson has directed DESE to administer unspent funds under the EANS IIA program, which provides funding to all eligible nonpublic schools to address the impact the COVID-19 emergency has had, and continues to have, on nonpublic school students and teachers in the State. These funds will remain available for obligation through September 1, 2024.

PURPOSE

DESE is providing guidance to all eligible nonpublic schools regarding requirements associated with the EANS IIA program. Nonpublic schools interested in participating in EANS IIA should carefully review the entire document before proceeding. DESE notes there are significant differences between EANS II and EANS IIA, including eligibility, allocation methodology, and the allowable use of funds. Nonpublic schools that received a Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan are eligible to receive assistance under EANS IIA, based on the definition of nonpublic schools. EANS IIA requirements are covered in detail in separate sections elsewhere in this document.

NONPUBLIC SCHOOL DEFINITION

For purposes of the EANS IIA program, an eligible nonpublic school is an elementary or secondary school that:

- Is nonprofit;
- Is a nonpublic school, (neither a school district, a neglected/delinquent institution nor a charter school as defined by Missouri law);
- Is accredited, licensed, or otherwise operates in accordance with State law;
- Existed and operated prior to March 13, 2020, the date COVID-19 was declared a national emergency, and is still in operation;
- Provides instruction in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies to one or more grade levels that include at least one grade level from kindergarten – 12th grade; and
- Has a physical location and students, under normal circumstances, are instructed on-site.

Faith-based nonpublic schools are eligible to participate in the EANS IIA program to the same extent as other eligible nonpublic schools. All assistance provided under the program must be secular, neutral, and non-ideological.

A State Education Agency (SEA) may require an eligible nonpublic school to provide information in an application for services or assistance under the EANS IIA program to the extent the SEA deems reasonable to ensure expedited and timely provision of services or assistance. In Missouri, the SEA is DESE. At a minimum, the SEA must request the following information from an eligible nonpublic school:

- The number of students from low-income families enrolled in the nonpublic school in School Year (SY) 2022-2023 and
- A description of the emergency services or assistance the nonpublic school is requesting the SEA provide.

EANS IIA PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility

Under the EANS IIA program, assistance is available to nonpublic schools that meet the nonpublic school definition.

Unlike EANS II nonpublic schools that participated in the Small Business Administration's Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) on or after December 27, 2020, are eligible to participate in EANS IIA, as long as they met Missouri's definition of a nonpublic school.

Allocation Method

The allocation method provides a base allocation of \$10,000 per nonpublic school and adds a dollar amount for each economically deprived student served. The dollar amount per economically deprived student will be determined based on received applications from nonpublic schools, the number of economically deprived students in those nonpublic schools, and funds available. The allocation table is forthcoming.

Procurement

Under EANS IIA, funds may only be used for procurement. EANS IIA funds will not be disbursed to nonpublic schools but will be used to pay vendors directly for services and/or assistance provided.

OBLIGATION OF FUNDS

Nonpublic schools may request procurement assistance through September 1, 2024.

ALLOWABLE ASSISTANCE FOR PROCUREMENT

A nonpublic school receiving allowable assistance under the EANS IIA program shall use such assistance to address educational disruptions resulting from COVID- 19 for:

1. Supplies to sanitize, disinfect, and clean school facilities;
2. Professional development for educators and paraprofessionals to address learning loss;
3. Redeveloping instructional plans, including curriculum development, for remote learning, hybrid learning or to address learning loss;
4. Purchasing evidence-based instructional materials;
5. Initiating and maintaining education and support services or assistance for remote learning, hybrid learning, or to address learning loss; and
6. Providing mental health services and support.

UNALLOWABLE ASSISTANCE

The following items and activities are **not** allowed under the EANS IIA program:

1. Personal protective equipment (PPE);
2. Improving ventilation systems, including windows, or portable air purification systems to ensure healthy air in the non-public school;
3. Physical barriers to facilitate social distancing;
4. Other materials, supplies, or equipment to implement public health protocols, including guidelines and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for the reopening and operation of school facilities to effectively maintain the health and safety of students, educators, and other staff during COVID 19;
5. Expanding capacity to administer coronavirus testing to effectively monitor and suppress coronavirus, to conduct surveillance and contact tracing activities, and to support other activities related to coronavirus testing for students, teachers, and staff at the nonpublic school;
6. Educational technology (including hardware, software, connectivity, assistive technology, and adaptive equipment) to assist students, educators, and other staff with remote or hybrid learning;
7. Leasing of sites or spaces to ensure safe social distancing to implement public health protocols, including guidelines and recommendations from the CDC;
8. Transportation cost;
9. Training and professional development for staff on sanitation, the use of personal protective equipment, and minimizing the spread of infectious diseases;
10. Direct or indirect financial assistance to scholarship granting organizations or related entities for elementary or secondary education; and
11. Providing or supporting vouchers, tuition tax credit programs, education savings accounts, scholarships, scholarship programs, or tuition-assistance programs for elementary or secondary education.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The first step in the process for *all* interested nonpublic schools is to complete the [EANS IIA Program Registration](#) by September 29, 2023. Completing this form is required to provide DESE with an intent to participate in this program regardless of whether or not a nonpublic school has participated in ESEA assistance or assistance under EANS I or EANS II. Nonpublic schools that have not previously submitted the actual count (not a count based on proportionality methodology) of economically deprived students will be asked to supply those data as of October 1, 2022.

Nonpublic schools that have not registered in the Nonpublic Registration Form system in the past must first complete a [NONPUBLIC SCHOOL ADD/CHANGE REQUEST form](#). Please allow five business days for the NONPUBLIC SCHOOL ADD/CHANGE REQUEST to be approved and the nonpublic school granted access to the web application system. See Appendix A for a list of eligible nonpublic schools already registered in the Nonpublic Registration Form.

Nonpublic schools that have completed the EANS IIA Program Registration (due September 29, 2023) must complete the EANS IIA Program Application. The program application will be open October 16, 2023 through November 16, 2023. The application can be found in [DESE Applications Sign-In \(DAS\)](#) in the Nonpublic Registration Form system.

It is important to note that nonpublic schools that are registered in the Nonpublic Registration Form system and have said **yes to participating in Federal Programs and Title I services** and used Method 1, 2, 4 or 5 will complete the [EANS IIA Program Registration](#) to serve as an intent to apply to the EANS IIA Program.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS FOR NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS

Details on how to request assistance will be provided following the closure of the application process. DESE anticipates engaging a third-party contractor to facilitate expedited assistance. The third-party contractor will provide training on the procurement request process. DESE also anticipates publishing documentation to clarify the assistance request process. EANS IIA funds can be used for procurement only. Reimbursement is not allowed.

NONPUBLIC SCHOOL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

DESE will require separate data collection for nonpublic school compliance with federal reporting requirements.

PUBLIC CONTROL OF ASSISTANCE

Public control of funds for assistance that is provided to nonpublic schools under the EANS IIA program remains with DESE, including title to materials procured with EANS IIA funds. Procurement of services will be provided by DESE through a contract with a public or private entity. DESE will maintain records of the assistance provided to each of the nonpublic schools.

Items procured with EANS IIA funds for the nonpublic schools shall only be used for an authorized purpose of the EANS IIA program until September 1, 2024, or until the supplies are no longer required under the EANS IIA program. Once the supplies are no longer needed for the EANS IIA program, DESE may remove the item from the school or allow the

nonpublic to continue use of items for other allowable expenditures under other federal programs such as the Elementary and Secondary Education Act or Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. DESE may retain control or transfer the title and control to the local education agency where the nonpublic school resides.
