

## Cabot Pacific in Revelstoke, British Columbia

### APPROACH

- Our goal was to find the best 18-holes for golf that the site could offer.
- The best golf courses provide an interesting exploration of a landscape. The better and more varied the landscape, the better the golf course should be. Therefore, it is the architect's job to put the pieces together and create a special journey.
- The site at Revelstoke is an exceptional one. So, we worked hard to ensure the routing would make the most of the bench's cliff-like edge, the numerous creeks, and incredible vistas. The creeks are natural drainage channels from the mountain, which have been protected and utilized to enhance the strategy of many holes.
- Scale in such a setting will be important. As such, wide fairways, large greens, and bold bunkering will be used to match nature's grandeur.
- Walkability, and an emphasis on the ground game, will again play a major role in this Cabot product. We plan to have Cabot Pacific deliver as much intrigue as its Eastern predecessors.
- Our design-build approach will ensure that the product is both bold and nuanced ... and most importantly fun to play!

### VISION

- **Nestled between the town of Revelstoke and the meandering Columbia River, Cabot Revelstoke resort will feature the world renowned golf and amenities with which the Cabot brand has become synonymous. Upstaged only by the majestic natural beauty surrounding it, Cabot Pacific golf course will take advantage of the diverse landscape and exquisite natural topography. Set on a bench of land at the base of Mount MacKenzie, the course will be routed over a gently rolling piece of ground perched high above the river valley below. The scale of the Cabot Pacific will reflect its setting with large greens, wide fairways and bold bunkering. Golfers can expect great natural contours and play among and around cliffs, creeks and large rocky outcroppings set against the stunning views mountain golf is loved for.**
- We plan to add to Canada's sterling reputation (forged by Stanley Thompson and the Canadian Railways ... hence the name!) for mountain golf.

- Great golf sites in the mountains are not that easy to find. Most of the best have been located down in the river valleys because the movement cannot be too severe. The Revelstoke site is ideal for golf in that respect. Its elevated placement on a natural “bench” at the foot of Mount MacKenzie, and overlooking Williamson Lake and the Columbia River, provides long views of surroundings that are just jaw-droppingly beautiful.
- Cabot Pacific will expand upon the existing offerings of the world-class ski resort at Revelstoke Mountain Resort.
- Development will include a 150-room lodge, real estate, and an 18-hole golf course
- The golf course has been designed by Rod Whitman and will be constructed by the firm of Whitman, Axland & Cutten ([www.WAC.golf](http://www.WAC.golf))
