

RCSD Facts Sheet for Reopening of Schools – Phase 3

Phase 3 of the District’s reopening plan includes the return of approximately 2,896 students to hybrid/in-person learning starting on Monday, February 22. This student population includes 7 – 12 students in general, bilingual, and special education programs.

Approximately 1,390 staff members are returning to school buildings as part of Phase 3.
