Our Mission – The Sheffield Farmers' Market is a venue for people to have meaningful interactions with the growers, producers, and artisans who make the goods we need right here in the southern Berkshires. Nourish your body and the community we live in by supporting our local small farms, land, and economy.

Our Background – The cultural and historical tradition of farmers' markets in Sheffield dates back to the 18th century. Founded in 2000, the Sheffield Farmers' Market summer schedule runs from May through October on Friday afternoons at the Old Parish Church. This year we are holding a Winter Market at Dewey Hall 10am - 1pm on the second Saturdays of December 11, January 8, February 12, and March 12. Come on out for some local goods, live music, and community cheer during the cold winter months! Market vendors sell local produce, meats, baked goods, crafts and gifts, and live music by local artists.

Our Blueprint for Success – The Sheffield Farmers' Market is a non-profit, locally crowdsourced endeavor. We are so grateful to our local businesses who sponsor the market, festival days, live music, and our SNAP Match program.
