Kelly and Valerie Molino both graduated from Lee High School and will attend the University of Massachusetts Amherst. Annette Boyko, a graduate of Monument Mountain Regional High School, will attend Roger Williams University in the fall. All three recipients are residents of Lee.

Scholarship recipients and their families will be invited to attend the awards dinner following the Lee Chamber Golf Open, where they will be formally recognized for their achievements.
