Dear MAUE parents,

Superintendent Charlotte Seals sent out a press release today with updates concerning our re-entry to school plan and virtual learning. Please see below for information on how these updates affect our MAUE students and families.

Virtual Learning Option: Any MAUE student that is currently enrolled at our school can sign up for the virtual learning option for the 2020-2021 school year. The guidelines for virtual learning can be found on our district webpage under the Back to School and Guidelines section. To enroll your MAUE student in virtual learning for the 2020-2021 school year please **visit the Madison County School's district webpage and fill out the Virtual Learning Enrollment Form on or before Friday, July 24 at noon.** We must have your students' names on or before Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup> in order for your child to pursue the virtual learning option. Once your student enrolls in the virtual learning option, they will be required to pursue that option until the end of the first semester.

MAUE Back to School Safety Protocols: Once our plans are finalized and approved, we will share the information with all of our families via email and on our website and PTO Facebook page.

First Days of School for Students Returning for Face-to-Face Instruction: The plan in the Jaguar Zone is still to divide the students by alphabet for the 'soft start' days.

- Students whose last names begin with A-L will attend school on August 6<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>
- Students whose last names begin with M-Z will attend school on August 7<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>
- All students will remain at home for August 14<sup>th</sup> for a Virtual Learning Day
- All teachers and students will report to building on August 17<sup>th</sup>, and a regular schedule begins with all students reporting each day.
