Road Ahead for GCS: Our COVID-19 Policy for 2021-22

COVID just doesn't want to go away, and it may be with us for the rest of this year. There are a lot of questions about GCS's approach this coming year.

We have continued to research and follow information on both sides of the COVID discussion. Sadly, one side has been removed and suppressed. Science has always been an active discussion between the different experts to come to some type of conclusion sometimes with varying opinions.
