



Chalice Camp Policies & Procedures Overview, 2026

You will receive a detailed welcome letter for Camp in early July with more detailed information about Camp schedules and policies.

General Information:

- Drop-off begins at 8:45 pm and Camp begins at 9:00 pm.
- Pick-up is at 4:00 pm. Please make arrangements if you are going to be late. You are responsible for paying a late fee of \$20 if you arrive after 4:15 pm.
- Please check your child in at the kiosk when you arrive to Camp and sign them out on the clipboard at the check-in table.
- If your child cannot make it to camp for the day or you have any other message for the Chalice Camp Director, please call 206-454-7720. Aria can also be reached via text or phone call at 360-594-1646.
- Chalice Camp keeps a fully equipped first aid backpack and all of the children's emergency forms on site at all times. Please make sure the information you provide is clear and accurate. If your child requires specific medical equipment (i.e. Epi-pen, allergy medicine, inhaler, etc.) please send these items to camp with instructions and notify Aria. There will be a CPR/First-Aid certified staff member on hand at all times.
- Put sunscreen on your child each morning. Sunscreen will be available at check-in. We can also re-apply if you wish.

Things to Bring:

- Send a lunch with your child each day, along with a bottle of water (labeled with their name!). Please remember that UUC children's programs are NUT FREE. Please plan nut-free lunches.
- We will provide your child with a mid-morning and afternoon snack.
- Send your child with weather-appropriate clothing. This might include a hat for playing outside in the sun.
- Label any loose items.
- This is an indoor/outdoor camp, so consider sending clothes you don't mind getting dirt and/or paint on. Sturdy shoes appropriate for running and playing are appreciated.

Your child is welcome to bring a book to read during open choice time or lunch. They are also welcome to bring a favorite stuffy, or a creative activity (origami, puzzle, etc - should all be labeled with their name). Please leave items such as video games, MP3 players, and tablets at home. This is to help children connect with one another and be fully present. *UUC and Chalice Camp Staff cannot take responsibility for loss or damage of items brought to camp.*
