

Grandjean Camping Trip at Sawtooth Lodge

When: July 12th – 14th

Location: Grandjean, ID Take Hwy 21, then turn on the dirt road (Forest Road 700) located 27 miles northeast of Lowman, between mile markers 93 & 94 then go 6 miles on the dirt road to the lodge. Total travel time is approximately 2.5 – 3 hours from Boise. Beautiful location next to the Payette river with mountains on both sides.

Camping will be the lower meadow, in your tent or your camper. Space can be reserved online at www.sawtoothlodge.com or call reservations 208.907.6447 or the lodge 208.259.3331

Swimming pool is onsite. Heated by a natural hot spring. Bring your suit and towel.

Dogs are allowed, but must be on a leash while at the campground. \$15/dog per stay

Things to do:

- Lodge has small café with food for sale, including ice
- Campfire in the evening for roasting marshmallows, conversations, socializing and singing
- Fishing – little trout close to camp and bigger ones close by at Bull Trout Lake. Ray will lead fishing trips, if anyone is interested
- Nature walks near campground and up trailheads
- Trek to the falls (short but steep)
- Saturday afternoon potluck dinner including dutch oven cooking. Bring something good to share

Other stuff:

- It is cold in the mountains at night. If you are tenting, bring something to insulate you on the ground, i.e., air mattress.
