
I had been invited several times to go on the retreat and I really did not see that it was necessary since I had been on other retreats and I really did not see how this one would help me.

I felt as if my life of sin and God's forgiveness that the Lord given me was like a trophy I had earned, it was not a sincere repentance. I felt like I was bragging about the mercy of God, and at that moment I realized that something was going on inside of me that was not good. I started to meditate at that moment, and I felt that something was wrong inside of me. I was repeating 10 or 20 times the same testimony and I was always talking about the mercy of God as it was something to brag about, but inside of myself I was not feeling this forgiveness that I so desperately needed.

From that moment, I decided that I had to have a more intimate and intense approach with the Lord through prayer, the Rosary, the Mass, and visits to the Blessed Sacrament requesting that the blinders be removed from my eyes and my soul. I asked God to enlighten me so I could know what was needed to be free of those feelings and find forgiveness and freedom from my mistake. I knew I needed to forgive myself with a sincere repentance and I decided to go to the retreat my soul so long ago needed, Rachel's Vineyard. I needed the healing from my abortions to stop the bleeding in my soul. The first opportunity that came up to go, I couldn't because of my work, the second time my husband had an accident and on the third occasion I begged the Lord to grant me the grace to be able to go and He answered my plea.

This very important moment in my life arrived to go to Rachel's Vineyard and live the unique experience where feelings and memories were found in those moments of meditation where I realized that a part of me not was healed and that it is a process of continuous conversion.

Thanks to this encounter with the Lord, He gave me the opportunity to amend my mistake. I was able to have a spiritual encounter with my children, hug them, giving them names, crying with them and asking them for forgiveness. I told them I was so sorry for not giving them the opportunity

I give thanks to the Lord for his infinite mercy, for His faithfulness, for His freedom, for His love because He never abandoned me in difficult moments in my life and always held me in His arms when I was falling.
