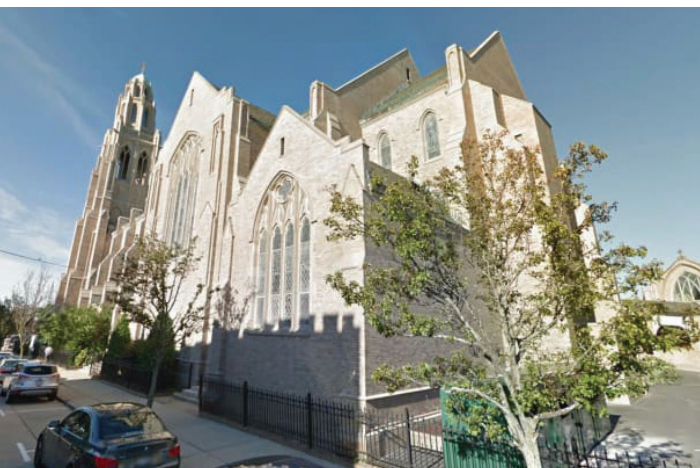

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES
