Re: Return of Product to C&S Wholesale Grocers, Inc. (C&S) for Reclamation

Dear Valued Customer:

As you are aware, hazardous waste management is a critical part of the reclamation process. At C&S, we have implemented procedures for the appropriate disposal of hazardous waste. However, as a customer of C&S, you also have certain compliance related responsibilities associated with products returned to C&S for purposes of reclamation.

When determining which items are going to be sent to reclamation for processing, please do not return any products which might constitute hazardous waste under any applicable local, state and/or federal laws or regulations. Examples of items that are considered hazardous waste are non-saleable products which are leaking, or expired – such as, but not limited to, liquid detergents, medicines, nail polish, aerosols, household cleaners, bleach, ammonia, light bulbs and batteries, none of these items should be returned to C&S through the reclamation process.
