He is the key force behind *International Dot Day*, a teacher-initiated, annual program, which celebrates the themes of creativity and courage in Peter's book *The Dot*. Participating teachers, librarians and students now number over 10 million in 170 countries. Their most recent books include *Going Places*, a picture book about creativity and engineering, and a STEM-meets-Arts (STEAM) early chapter book series called *Sydney & Simon*, which includes *Full STEAM Ahead!*, *Go Green!*, and *To the Moon!*
