This web event will focus on tools that can be used to assess the extent of youth and family voice in advising and decision making in organizations, committees/councils, and systems of care. Presenters will describe several tools intended to provide concrete, practical information to develop plans for improvement and technical assistance including:

- The validated Y-VAL assessment tool built around eight specific measurement domains
- The Y-VOC assessment tool; shortened version of the Y-VAL
- The FAM-VOC assessment tool measuring the extent to which councils, committees, and advisory boards support family member involvement

Presenters will provide examples on the use of the tools and participants will have an opportunity for questions and answers.
