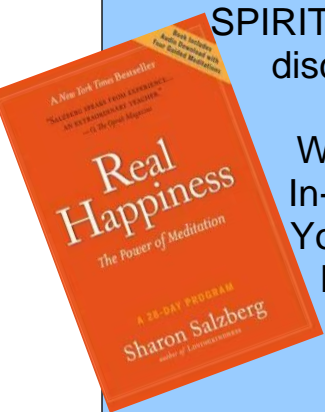

The birds at The Kirk bring sure delight to all of us!

I watch the bluebirds fly low from one side of the grounds to

another and the finches keep us company right outside our office windows.

Unfortunately, I have some sad news. As Marion Brown was walking the grounds, she checked the bluebird box and found that two babies had died in the box. She plans to donate a bluebird box system with new box fitted with anti-predator opening and a baffle on the pole to keep snakes out.

Now that Spring is here, we need to be sure to keep the feeders clean. There has been a serious eye disease problem this Spring that has caused blindness. It is spread via bird poop at feeders. Finches are especially vulnerable. Many people have cared for the bird feeders over the years— most recently, Susie Mote, Tina Bechtle, Mike and Lynelle Gardner. Thank you all so much!
