Durham Ferry Outdoor Education Center is nestled in a large meander of the San Joaquin River, located approximately 7 miles south of Manteca.

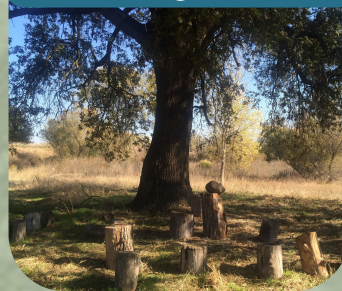
Grade Levels
