**All classes are instructed by qualified staff presenting curriculum of the National Fire Academy. Completion of course study and material will entitle students to Kentucky fire service training hours and a National Fire Academy attendance certificate.**

## 2020 COURSES AVAILABLE

### **Class # 1 – Fire Investigation: First Responders (FIFR)** **NFA Course ID 00379**

This two-day course is designed specifically to provide a clear definition of the role of first responders in fire investigation and provide essential knowledge to enable them to recognize the potential of intentionally set fires, preservation and protection of evidence, and proper reporting of information to appropriate officials. By strengthening the partnership between first responders and investigators, the chances for successfully solving arson-related crimes will increase. The course includes topics such as fire behavior, critical observations of the first responder, fire causes, scene security and evidence preservation, legal considerations, and documentation of findings.

This course is designed for all fire and emergency services personnel who might conduct preliminary investigations into the origin and cause of fires.

*Interested students must complete "Initial Fire Investigation for First Responders" (Q0379), in addition to ICS-100 and ICS-200, available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course. Students who do not complete the (Q0379) course requirement and provide proof of completion may not be issued a National Fire Academy completion certificate.*

### **Class # 2 – Leadership in Supervision: Frameworks to Success (LSFS)** **NFA Course ID 00648**

This two-day course provides the supervisor with the knowledge and skills to perform successfully in the fire and emergency medical services environments. The course addresses professionalism, resilience, emotional intelligence and situational awareness, as well as managing conflict, delegating mentoring, coaching, empowering and building collaboration and synergy for professional growth.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

### **Class # 3 – Incident Safety Officer (ISO)** **NFA Course ID 00729**

This two-day course examines the Safety Officer's role at emergency responses. A specific focus on operations within an Incident Command System (ICS) as a Safety Officer is a main theme. Response to all-hazards types of situations will be emphasized.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

## **Class # 4 – Leadership in Supervision: Perspectives in Thinking (LSPT)**

**NFA Course ID O0647**

This two-day course provides the fire/EMS supervisor with the conceptual foundation and framework for success in leadership roles by exploring creative, analytical, political and critical thinking perspectives. The course addresses skills needed for assessing situations from multiple perspectives, making critical decisions, fostering creativity and innovation, and using persuasion.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

## **Class # 5 – Training Operations for Small Departments (TOSD)**

**NFA Course ID O0290**

This two-day course is designed to provide students with some basic tools and skills to coordinate training in a small fire/EMS organization. A training function in a smaller department typically includes conducting training drills and coordinating training with the state fire commission training division and other nearby departments. This is an excellent class for in-house instructors and department training officers.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

## **Class # 6 – Shaping the Future (STF)**

**NFA Course ID F0602**

This two-day course is designed to assist first and second-level supervisors and company officers in developing knowledge and skills in contemporary approaches to organizational problem-solving. The course topics include the use of creative approaches to identify trends, applying problem-solving methodologies, the application of continuous improvement, subordinate's resistance to change and strategies to implement necessary change.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

## **Class # 7 – Strategies and Tactics for Initial Company Operations (STICO)**

**NFA Course ID O0455**

This 2-day NFA course focuses on basic leadership skills and techniques needed to improve command and management effectiveness. It addresses techniques and approaches to problem-solving, identifying and assessing the needs of subordinates, running meetings and decision-making.

*It is preferred that interested students complete courses ICS-100 (Q0462) and ICS-200 (Q0463), available through NFA Online at <https://www.usfa.fema.gov/training/nfa/courses/online.html> , prior to participating in this classroom-based course.*

## Federal Student Identification Number (SID#)

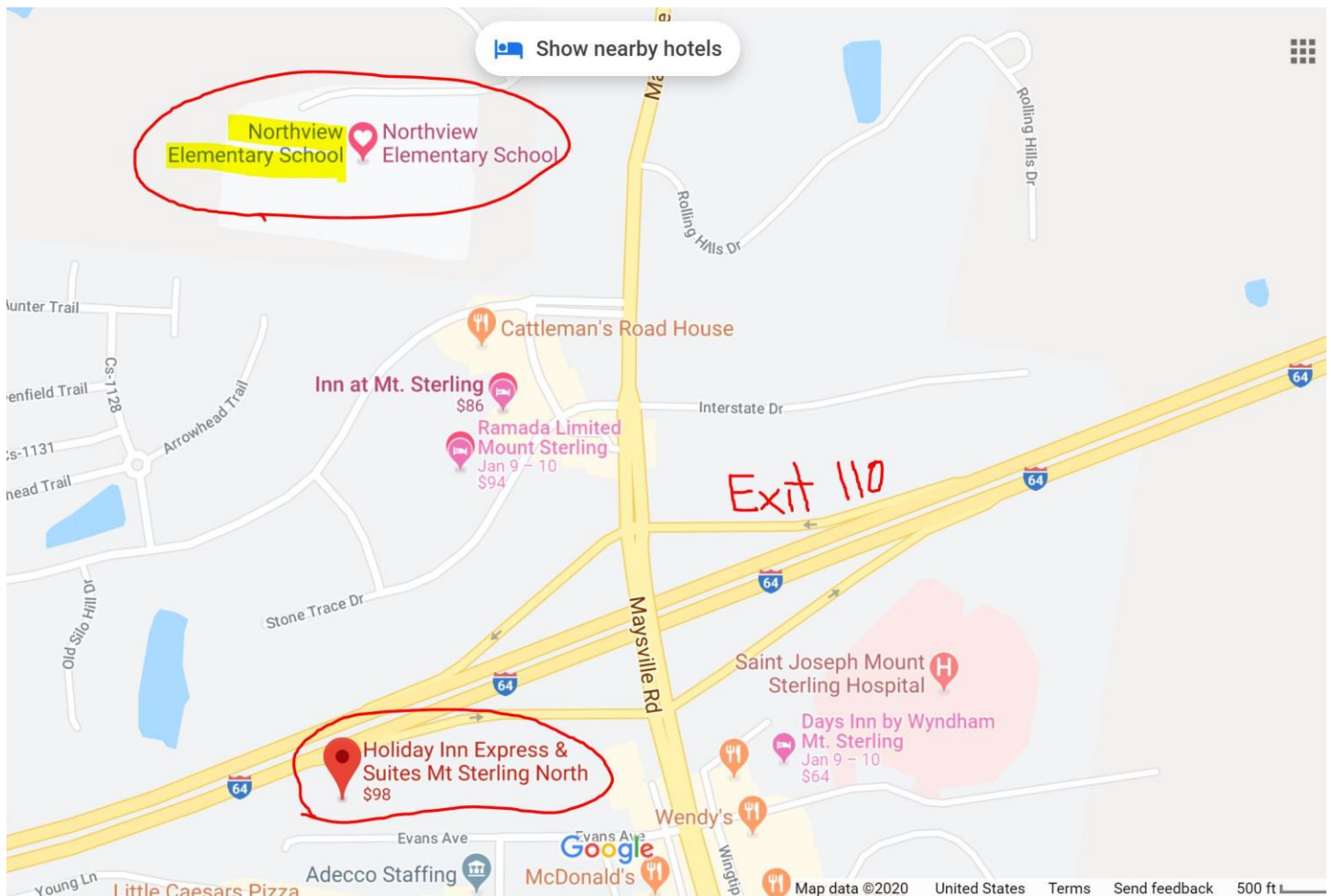
