

MANAGING TIME



Establish a routine and regular schedule with your child that allows them time to revise. Show them how to proceed step by step. Make sure your child has eaten and offer them breaks if you think they need to move around or calm down.

MANAGING SPACE AND NOISE



To concentrate better, some children like a little background noise, while others prefer silence. See what seems to work best for your child. The chosen environment should promote attention and learning.

SUPERVISE THE WORK



Even if you feel your child is more independent, continue to supervise their revision period and check that the work has been done properly. This shows them that you are interested in what they are doing and that you are there for them if necessary.

HAVE A GREAT TIME!



If your child is quite active, let them run down the hallway to spell their vocabulary words.
For example, practice math exercises with your child by writing on a board or window.
