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English School Boards (e.g., English Montreal School Board [EMSB], Lester B. Pearson School Board [LBPSB], Riverside School Board, etc.)	<a href="#">To be verified on the website of the specific local school board.</a>	In-person retake courses, sometimes online through LEARN, and administration of MEQ examinations.	Although they generally give priority to their own students, most English school boards allow students from private schools or out-of-territory students to register for summer courses for a fee, or at least to use the board as an exam centre for writing MEQ uniform examinations.		English		Depends on the centre designated each summer, such as Laurier Macdonald for EMSB or Macdonald High School for LBPSB.
