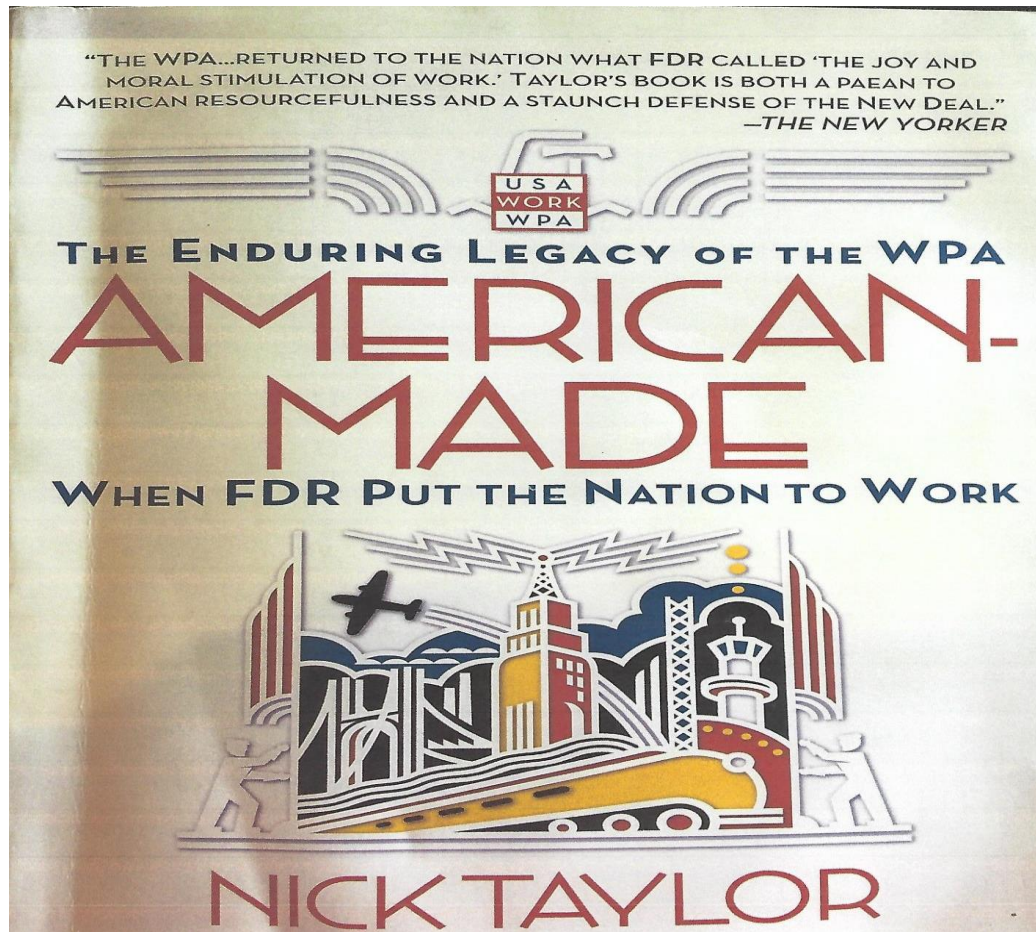


VG History Book Club
