

Sunday Volunteer Roles

GREETERS – need two each Sunday

Greeter One: stand just inside the exterior sanctuary entrance

Greeter Two: stand or sit near the hospitality table that will be moved into the open area of the narthex.

- Greet everyone
- Greeter Two: assist any visitors and ask them to sign in/write down their contact info on a card or in the book
- If an individual is not wearing a mask, then offer a disposable mask one. (There will be a supply on the hospitality table and in the entry way).
- Ask people to find an available pew or direct them to the usher
- Stay in the narthex during the service to direct someone to the restroom

USHERS – need one each Sunday

- Help with traffic flow in the narthex
- Help make the best use of our space by encouraging people to fill the front of the sanctuary and leave space on the side aisles for latecomers. If there are only one or two persons in a pew, ask them to move to one end so we can get others in the opposite end.
- Sitting with household members is fine but otherwise spread out as marked in the pews – blue tape means leave that row empty.

Requirements/expectations

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to worship service (9:45 am)
- Wear a mask
- Be friendly remind folks to wear masks, and social distance

Please know that while some of the tasks on the job description include reminders to mask and social distance, we believe worshipers will follow guidelines -- meaning you will be the friendly face without fear of awkward situations. If something unusual happens, Pastor Aaron is prepared to jump in.

We appreciate your flexibility as we make modifications to this role as we learn each week.
