ART

DRAWING AND SKETCHING (2nd grade and up)

Drawing and sketching are fundamental art skills to value and learn about from artist, Elizabeth Coerver. Young artists will draw from life, work on proportion and shading, and learn about one and two point perspective.

Mon. 2/26-3/25 (no class 3/11), 4:15-5:45 PM, \$290 + \$20 supply fee

DRAWING ANIMALS (2nd grade & up)

Learn to apply drawing skills to creating pictures of different creatures with artist, Elizabeth Coerver. Student artists will study methods for drawing animals realistically, work on proportion and shading, and learn about the importance of variety.

AMERICAN RED CROSS CLASSES

CPR/AED/FIRST AID TRAINING (11 years-adult)

The American Red Cross Simulation Learning places you in the middle of emergencies, making decisions and providing care. Students will complete the SIM training online at home, then attend an instructor led class emphasizing hands on learning for first aid, breathing emergencies, CPR, and using an AED.

AMERICAN RED CROSS CLASSES (CONT'D)

BE THE BEST BABYSITTER IN TOWN (11 years & up)

This class offers instruction in child care, first aid, and pediatric CPR. Students will gain confidence to make smart decisions and stay safe while babysitting. Part of the class must be completed online at home, before the class meets. Bring a lunch and drink.

LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION COURSE (15 years & up)

This American Red Cross class gives students the knowledge & skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies, provide care for breathing/cardiac emergencies, injuries, & sudden illness. Prerequisites: swim 300 yards continuously; tread water for 2 minutes using only legs; complete timed event that includes swimming, surface dive to depth of 7-10 feet, and retrieval of a 10 pound object, returning to starting point, and exit the water without using steps or a ladder. Students must complete 7 hours of online coursework before the first day of class. Successful completion of the course earns an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR AED valid for 2 years. Max 10 students.

LIFEGUARD REVIEW (15 years & up)

Abbreviated Lifeguarding course that reviews course information, and allows practice of skills & knowledge before testing. Must hold current certification in Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED to participate. Students must complete 7 hours of online coursework before the first day of class. Successful completion of the course earns an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR AED valid for 2 years. Max 10 students.

CHESS

CHESS FOR BEGINNERS (K-4th grade)

Introduce your youngster to the game of chess, an interest that will last a lifetime! Taught by qualified, committed instructors from USA Chess, the format provides instruction and supervised playing time with peers. Kids love to play chess!

Class concludes with a parent presentation.
