PAYMENT PLAN

The offered *payment plan* option is a courtesy to our parents who prefer to stagger payments. It is not a monthly payment but rather *installment payments* for the semester, and as such, will be billed accordingly.

REFUND POLICY *PLEASE READ CAREFULLY*

Withdrawals more than 2 weeks before the first day of class will receive a tuition refund less a \$35 processing fee. Withdrawals less than 2 weeks before the first day of class will be charged a \$45 cancellation fee in addition to the \$35 processing fee.

Once classes have begun, there are no refunds given due to non-participation for any reason. *No credits or refunds are issued for the non-refundable Facility Fees.*

If due to a long term illness or injury a student cannot complete the full class series, a partial prorated credit may be applied to the cost of future participation. *No refunds.* Any credit issued due to injury or illness is valid for the concurrent semester only. If not used during the concurrent semester, credit becomes forfeit.

PEE WEE – Ages 3&4 - The goal of the program is to instill excitement and a desire to make tennis a lifetime activity. Hand eye and group participation skills are stressed along with basic introduction to the fundamental grips and swings. Activities conducted with mini-tennis nets on the indoor Quick Start court.

RED BALL - Ages 5&6 - Emphasis is on hand eye coordination, racquet control, basic technique of ground strokes and volleys plus movement. Introduction to basic singles and doubles play. Activities conducted on short court (USTA Red Ball court dimension) and the footwork court with several teaching aids such as tees and modified tees.

INTERMEDIATE - Ages 7-10 – Beginner, Intermediate/Advanced Intermediate players continue work on the refinement of basic tennis skills. Drills and rallying are introduced to simulate match play situations. Activities conducted mostly on short court (USTA Red Ball court dimension) and the footwork court. The class begins with Red Balls with Orange Ball and USTA Orange Ball court dimensions introduced later in the session.

ORANGE BALL – Ages 8-10&1/2 – Advanced Intermediate players that have had prior Red Ball training and some Orange Ball experience. Rallying and point play are emphasized with both red and (mostly) orange balls. Players must be goal oriented and playing USTA Orange Ball tournaments during the year.

GREEN BALL - Players continue to hone technique, footwork skills and are introduced to mental toughness skills as they pertain to match play for rising tournament players.

TOURNAMENT AND ELITE

TRAINING – Intense programs for goal-oriented junior players. Refinement of movement, balance and shot production are incorporated in match play simulation drills to help the player construct points. Video analysis and mental toughness training continues as a means of helping the players learn how to correct flaws and win matches.
