## Timeline:

Submissions are due to the Bradfield front office by end-of-day Friday, October 3rd.  
Judges' selection will be announced on BBTv on Friday, October 10th.

## Judging:

Submissions will be judged by two local artists and proud Bradfield alums, Ryan Woodall and Lauren Cox. The judges will make their selection based on creativity, originality, composition and overall impact.
