### **ART**

#### **DRAWING AND SKETCHING (2nd grade & up)**

Drawing and sketching are fundamental art skills to value and learn about from artist, Elizabeth Coerver. Young artists will draw from life, work on proportion and shading, and learn about one and two point perspective.

#### **DRAWING ANIMALS (2nd grade & up)**
