Supporting Ways & Means VP (Fundraising)

Spirit Wear

The spirit wear chair supports the fundraising chair with selected items for sale, pricing and purchasing stock for Registration, and works with the financial and communications team to advertise the spiritwear sale. They coordinate with our supplies to ensure delivery and ensure that all orders are completed.

Silent Auction

Supporting Programs Vice President

Greek Day (6th grade)

We need two 6th grade parents to work with the social studies staff on a fun day in the Spring where the 6th graders learn about Ancient Greece through hands-on activities. The PTSA works to provide the togas made of linen and ribbon, and the Greek style snack.. (Two chairs and volunteers)

Diversity & Cultural Celebration

We would like to create a Fall (September or October) on-campus evening community event to celebrate our multicultural community. The chair would work to recruit volunteers and involve families, student clubs and our local community in celebrating our rich diversity, including world cultures, regional cultures within the USA, LGBTQ+ and disability culture. (Two chairs and volunteers)

Mindfulness Fest

The Chair will work with the Principal and BCHD to create a new community event on campus focused on Mindfulness. . (One chair and volunteers)

Family Stem Night

The chair recruits student clubs and local businesses and organizations to showcase STEM activities at Family STEM night in the spring (usually May). The Chair will recruit participants, advertise the event and organize volunteers.. (Two chairs and volunteers)

7th Grade Science Fair Chair

Works with the 7th Grade Science teacher to display the 7th Grade science projects in the cafeteria for the Family STEM night and recruit parent volunteers for judging.(One or two chairs and volunteers)

8th Grade Legacy Project Elder Reception

The Legacy Project is an 8th grade project run by the ELA department. The PTSA chair only provides refreshments for the reception with grandparents. (One chair)

Supporting Communications
