- 4. The facilitators' activities will focus on ecouraging small group conversations and resources.
 - Session format: Large group open 10 min; Small group breakouts 40 min, Large group close 10 min

Large group 10 min

The facilitator opens the session with setting the tone and context for the conversation. Then they will provide the ground rules for the conversations. The facilitator well let participants know that it is not easy having tough, but important conversation; and we have provided an anonymous link in the chat where individuals can share thoughts and concerns (worried about saying something wrong, appearing racist or sexist, or being labeld as something they're not).
