2018-2019 School Grades Highlights

District Highlights:

- MCSD remains an “A” rated school district in the state of Florida
- MCSD remains the only “A” rated school district on the Treasure Coast
- MCSD is ranked 12th out of 67 school districts in the state of Florida
- MCSD improved from a ranking of 15th in 2017-18 to a ranking of 12th in 2018-19
- MCSD increased their total points earned from 691 in 2017-18 to 712 in 2018-19
- MCSD increased their Middle School Acceleration points from 63 points in 2017-18 to 70 points in 2018-19
- MCSD is tied for 10th in the state for English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile
- MCSD is tied for 9th in the state for Math Achievement
- MCSD is tied for 6th in the state for Math Learning Gains
- MCSD is tied for 8th in the state for Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile
- MCSD is tied for 5th in the state for Social Studies Achievement

School Grade Increases:

- **Warfield Elementary School** increased their school grade from “C” in 2017-18 to “A” in 2018-19
- **SeaWind Elementary School** increased their school grade from “C” in 2017-18 to “A” in 2018-19
- **Crystal Lake Elementary School** increased their school grade from “B” in 2017-18 to “A” in 2018-19
- **Indiantown Middle School** increased their school grade from “C” in 2017-18 to “B” in 2018-19
- **Martin County High School** increased their school grade from “B” in 2017-18 to “A” in 2018-19

Schools with Increases of Total Points Earned Over 2017-2018

- **Sea Wind Elementary School** – increase of 106 total points
- **Palm City Elementary School** – increase of 27 total points
- **Port Salerno Elementary School** – increase of 5 total points
- **Hobe Sound Elementary School** – increase of 19 total points
- **Warfield Elementary School** – increase of 117 total points
- **Pinewood Elementary School** – increase of 24 total points

Spring 2019 Assessment Score Highlights

School Highlights:

- **Hobe Sound Elementary School** increased their English Language Arts Learning Gains by 12 percentage points over 2017-18 and their English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 14 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Sea Wind Elementary School** increased their English Language Arts Learning Gains by 10 percentage points over 2017-18, their English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 21 percentage points over 2017-18, their Math Achievement by 10 percentage points over 2017-18, their Math Learning Gains by 27 percentage points over 2017-18, their Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 26 percentage points over 2017-18, and their Science Achievement by 14 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Warfield Elementary School** increased their English Language Arts Learning Gains by 15 percentage points over 2017-18, their English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 24 percentage points over 2017-18, their Math Learning Gains by 27 percentage points over 2017-18, their Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 51 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Citrus Grove Elementary School** increased their English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 14 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Clark Advanced Learning Center** increased their Math Achievement by 14 percentage points over 2017-18
- **Pinewood Elementary School** increased their Math Learning Gains by 15 percentage points over 2017-18 and their Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 23 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **J.D. Parker Elementary School** increased their Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 12 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Palm City Elementary School** increased their Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile by 13 percentage points over 2017-18.
- **Murray Middle School** increased their Social Studies Achievement by 29 percentage points over 2017-18
- **Indiantown Middle School** increased their Social Studies Achievement by 32 percentage points over 2017-18
- **Stuart Middle School** increased their Middle School Acceleration by 12 percentage points over 2017-18
- **Dr. David L. Anderson Middle School** increased their Middle School Acceleration by 13 percentage points over 2017-18
- **Clark Advanced Learning Center** is ranked in the top 10% for each of the 9 components for which they received a grade
- **Hidden Oaks Middle School** is tied for 10th in the state for Math Learning Gains
- **Hidden Oaks Middle School** is in the top 10% of all middle schools in the state of Florida in English Language Arts Achievement, Math Achievement, Math Learning Gains, Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile, and Science Achievement
- **Sea Wind Elementary School** is in the top 10% of all elementary schools in the state of Florida for English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile and Math Learning Gains
- **Warfield Elementary School** is in the top 10% of all elementary schools in the state of Florida for English Language Arts Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile and Math Learning Gains of the Lowest Quartile
