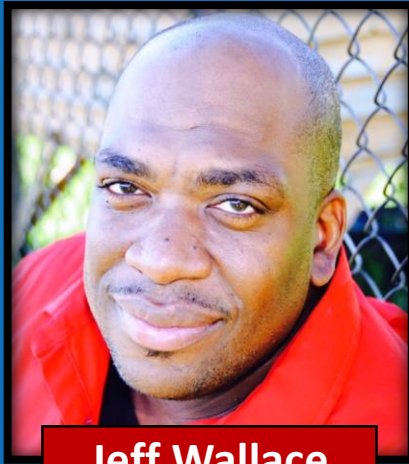

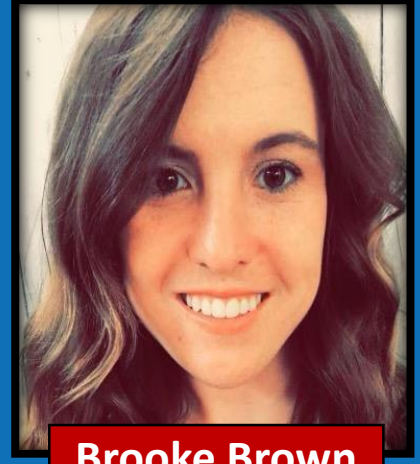
Jeff Wallace
