Liquor Establishment Briefing

July 2, 2020

- Indoor dining limited to 25% capacity, with a maximum of 50 customers in a room/floor
- Face covering must be worn by customers and employees, except when seated and eating/drinking
- All patrons must be **seated**
- Tables must be six feet apart, with no more than ten people per table
- Alcohol sales for on-site consumption must end at 11pm each day
- Alcohol sales to-go must end at 9pm daily and cannot be sold for consumption on the public way
- Establishments without food must limit seating to 2 hours per party
- Reservations strongly encouraged- it is the responsibility of the licensee to manage lines and ensure social distancing outside establishment



- Patrons seated
- Tables spaced 6 feet apart
- Masks worn by customers and employees
- Communication to patrons
- Limited indoor capacity



- Lines with no social distancing
- Standing room only
- Alcohol sales after 11pm
- To-go alcohol sold for consumption
- Indoor dining to full capacity

Risk level	New cases per day in Chicago	Indoor capacity	Indoor gathering size limit	Outdoor gathering size limit
High incidence	≥ 200 cases	25%	10 people	50 people
Moderate-high incidence	100-199 cases	25%	50 people	100 people
Moderate incidence	50-99 cases	50%	100 people	250 people
Moderate-low incidence	20-49 cases	75%	250 people	1000 people
Low incidence	≤ 20 cases	100%	1000 people	No limit

Note: Exact capacity and gathering size restrictions subject to change under the guidance of CDPH
