- What makes someone a good friend? (Or, a bad friend?)

- Tell me about someone who made you feel special. What did they do or say?
- Do you know anyone in our/your school who is being treated badly? How do you think they are feeling right now?
- How are your friends' families different from yours?
- Which of your friends do you admire most? And, why?
- Is it ever okay to lie? (Explore other ethical quandaries like this — our kids love to play judge!)
- What is your life motto? Or, make one up if you do not have one!
- What is your favorite family tradition?
- What is one thing you would change about your home?
