- Due to a generous grant from the Greenwich Alliance for Education, the cost to join this year will be only \$400 for the year, and \$50 for students who qualify for free/reduced lunch. Please plan to pay at the Parent Information Meeting at the end of October (date TBD will vary per school) if your child is selected.
