Thieves will not think twice about smashing a car window to steal your GPS Unit, Computers, phones, purses, Etc.

Suction cup marks and/or mounting brackets also indicate the strong possibility that a GPS Navigation system is within the vehicle.

Let's face it, most people do not go through the trouble of taking the GPS out of their vehicle and they do not take the time to secure it in the trunk.

Thieves then pounce on opportunity and you are more than likely left with a smashed window and a loss of your GPS.

GPS Navigation systems are quickly pawned or resold giving the thief an easy way to get cash. Knowing the serial # is the best way for Police to identify and recover your GPS.

What can you do?

1. Always lock your vehicle
2. Never leave windows open
3. Never leave any valuables inside your vehicle
4. Take the GPS Unit with you
5. Leave no indication within the vehicle that you possess a GPS Unit.
6. Record your GPS serial #
7. Don't leave loose change in cup holders
8. Never leave a spare key inside your vehicle

Always park your vehicle in a well lighted location
