MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER AND NOTE OF QUORUM

(Chrystal Davis, Special Populations Subcommittee Chair)

Ms. Chrystal Davis, Special Populations Subcommittee Chair called the meeting to order at 1:40 pm MST. Quorum was cited.

A: HireAbility Activity and Program Updates *(Dezeree Fraga, Student HireAbility Navigator)*

- Year-Round & Summer Earn and Learn

Ms. Dezeree Fraga, Student HireAbility Navigator, discussed the Project Search Graduation and the 2023/2024 cohort. Ms. Fraga discussed that the Year-Round & Summer Earn and Learn programs have been maxed out and that staff has requested additional funds for SEAL to add a few more slots as there are 18 individuals on the waiting list.

Ms. Odette Flores-Ruiz, Rural Development Manager, discussed the Migrant Seasonal Farm Workers Graduation in partnership with Region 19. Ms. Flores-Ruiz announced that there were 85 graduates. The Business Services Unit was able to get employers and exhibitors at the graduation to connect to the next plan.

D: Foster Youth Updates (*Janell Valles, Youth Program Manager*)

- Foster Youth Conference
- Onsite Service Delivery at PRIDE Center

Ms. Odette Flores-Ruiz, discussed the Foster Youth Conference she attended in April. Ms. Flores-Ruiz also discussed the onsite service delivery at PRIDE Center where youth go for help and can connect with other foster youth. WSB provides in-person services weekly on Fridays.

E: Report on the number of customers with disabilities served, employment for customers with disabilities, foster youth, MSFW, justice-involved, and veterans served (*Denisse Arrieta, Deputy Director*)

Ms. Denisse Arrieta reported the number of customers served from October 2022 through May 2023; 242 individuals with disabilities served; 28 foster youth; 62 MSFW; 409 veterans; and 269 justice-involved customers served.
