



Ready, Set, Cook it Safe! – September 24

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a virtual cooking event?

A virtual cooking event is when you cook at your home – while others are doing the same in their own homes - following a recipe and instructions provided to you by the event hosts.

How does this virtual cooking event work?

When you register for Ready, Set, Cook it Safe! you will receive a recipe and ingredients list one week prior to the event. During that week you can secure the ingredients needed to make the meal. On the day of the event you will receive a link to an audio file and additional recipe instructions (some prep work may be needed).

When you're ready to cook, press **play** on the audio link. Together we'll walk through preparing a safe and delicious meal!

Why should I participate in this event?

During a time of social distancing, this is a great event to cook in community with other event participants, all the while supporting a great cause- the non-profit [Partnership for Food Safety Education](#). You'll learn a few new cooking tips, get the chance to try a new meal using a "safe" recipe that includes safe food handling guidance.

You also get the chance to win some [amazing prizes](#) like a year of bacon and a Nespresso coffee maker!

If I can't be there on September 24 at 5 pm EST, can I still register and be eligible for prizes?

Absolutely! Register to get the event materials and carve out time that works for you to listen to the audio and cook along! You must listen to the audio and complete the recipe by October 4th to be entered into the random prize drawing. Prize drawing will occur on October 5 and winners will be notified.

How are prizes awarded?

You must listen to the audio and complete the recipe by October 4th to be entered into the random prize drawing. During the event, we will ask participants to post on the Partnership's [Facebook page](#) to show their meal preparation progress. It is this social media participation during the event that makes you eligible for prize drawings. Winners will be notified on October 5th.

Why is there a \$25 fee?

This is a fundraiser benefiting the non-profit Partnership for Food Safety Education.

Your \$25 donation goes straight into improving food safety education programming and outreach (\$25 makes it possible for PFSE to reach 650 Americans with safe food handling information!).
