Walking through Holy Week 2023

Holy Week 2023 begins on Palm Sunday, April 2 with Liturgy of the Palms and the reading of the Passion Narrative during worship.

This service kicks off a Holy Week filled with opportunities to gather as a worshipping community to listen to the Gospel story of the final week of Jesus' ministry leading to his Good Friday crucifixion and his resurrection on Easter Sunday.

One of the things I have found is that making the sacrifice of time to participate in the liturgies of Holy Week enhances the Easter morning celebration.

Please join me on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 6 pm in All Souls' Chapel for Evening Prayer and a reflection on the readings appointed for the day.

Also, on Wednesday at noon we will have our regularly scheduled Holy Eucharist and Healing liturgy in All Souls'.

Maundy Thursday liturgy will take place at 7 pm in our main sanctuary with the washing of feet, holy communion and the Stripping of the Altar in preparation for Good Friday.

On Good Friday you are invited to the noon Liturgy as we recount the day of Jesus' sacrifice. Then we will regather at 6:30 pm to walk our outdoor Stations of the Cross.

We will gather for the short Holy Saturday liturgy at 10 am and then we will begin to prepare our worship space and the rest of our campus for Easter morning.
