Threads of Gold

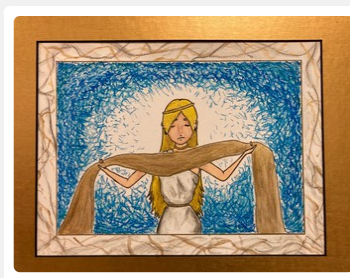
