Important Information



Camp Hours:

Drop Off: A full day of camp begins daily at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 5:30 p.m. Half day camp is 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. All campers will enter through the front red doors. Parents of campers rising K5- 6th may not walk their campers to class or go past the lobby. We will have a counselor to assist them in getting to their rooms. Campers may NOT be dropped off before 7:30.

Pick-up: To pick-up your camper, please dial 251-666-2991 and press extension #3 when prompted. You will then be connected to a Camp Wildcat counselor. Please state the camper's name and grade that you are picking up. Campers may only be picked up by the persons listed on the transportation list. Please be prepared to show proper identification if needed. A late fee of \$1 per minute will need to be collected if your camper is picked up after 12:30pm for half day and 5:30 p.m. for full day (not to exceed the full day rate). This fee must be paid before your child returns to Camp Wildcat.

Camp Medical Information:

No child should come to camp with fever or nausea. Sickness spreads quickly among small children. Children should be without fever for 24-hours before returning to school, without fever reducing medicine. If a decision is made that a student should return home, parents must arrange to have the student picked up within 30 minutes. Students may not remain at camp if they have a temperature greater than or equal to 100 degrees F, if they are vomiting, have diarrhea, or have sustained a head injury. Please also see attached Covid plan and Liability Release.

Camp Registration:

Campers will pay a non-refundable \$50 registration fee due with the Registration Form. The registration fee holds your spot at Camp Wildcat. We will accept registrations in order of the date received. The registration fee covers supplies and on and off-site activities. Your child's spot is not guaranteed without paying the registration fee. If you decide to cancel weeks, please be courteous for those on the waitlist so we can let them know that a spot has opened.

Camp Fees:

Camp Fees must be paid and registration completed before a student can be dropped off.

\$160 per week for five full days (Venmo or Check)

\$125 per week for five half days

A \$35.00 service charge will be collected on all checks returned due to insufficient funds or for any other reason. Returned checks will not be deposited. The returned check must be covered by a money order or certified check.

When paying with Venmo, you must put the camper's name and the week you are paying for in the subject line.

Camp Tuition:

Registration must be completed and payment made at the time of drop-off or the camper will not be allowed to stay at camp. If you pay for 5-days and only attend 1-4 days, no refunds will be given. If the school/class/camp closes for quarantine, your tuition will be applied to the next week, NOT REFUNDED. Arrangements will be made if there is not a future week to credit. Email campwildcat@slesmobile.org for cancellations.

Camp Meals:

Campers should bring their own snacks, lunch and drinks. However, there will be a Snack Shack on campus where campers may purchase drinks, snacks, and lunch food. Snack Shack money must be kept in a labeled ziplock and change will be sent home each day. No money will be kept on campus overnight.

All Day campers will need:

- Morning snack and drink
- Lunch and drink
- Afternoon snack and drink

Half day campers will need:

- Morning snack and drink
- Lunch and drink

Camp Dress:

Comfortable play clothes and closed- toe shoes are required each day. A towel and a swimsuit will be required on swim days. Please label all items. Apply sunscreen before camp.

Juniors:

Campers will need a rest mat, towel, and a change of clothes. Please label everything! If you are in the K3 room and are still potty training - don't forget your wipes, pull-ups and swim diapers! Please apply your sunscreen BEFORE Camp.

Seniors:

Campers will need a towel and a change of clothes on swim days. Apply your sunscreen BEFORE camp. Please label everything! **NO ELECTRONICS!**
