Schedule of Events & Important Information

Drop Off: Normal drop off for K-2 - 5th grade

6th-8th drop off at the Azalea Rd. entrance and report to the pavilion.

Parents who are not planning to attend Spring Festival should drop off as usual with K-2/K-3 parents parking only *temporarily* to escort students to class and K-4-5th grade parents utilizing the morning carpool drop off routes. Parents who are planning to attend Spring Festival, please follow the usual drop off procedure and proceed to the Cottage Hill Presbyterian Church for the shuttle and report to the athletic field afterward. *Parents are not to remain in the classrooms with students*.

K-2 parents may rejoin their students beginning with the 8:30 a.m. Courtyard Fun.

<u>Parking:</u> Parking is available at the Cottage Hill Presbyterian Church (4201 Cottage Hill Rd.) You will see balloons to mark the parking lot as well as a police officer directing traffic. A shuttle bus to campus will run constantly from 7:15 - 8:00 a.m. and shuttle during the morning hours. Please allow travel time to be on time for all events! *Please refrain from parking on the Japonica Campus.* These spaces are reserved for faculty with parking passes or for those who need accessible/close parking due to physical needs.

<u>Dress Code:</u> OUT OF UNIFORM. Students may wear their Spring Festival t-shirts or any other t-shirt for their red or black team color. Please dress students according to their team color. If you did not purchase a Spring Festival t-shirt and do not know your student's team color, please call the school office.

<u>Snacks/Food:</u> Snacks, drinks and lunch will be available for purchase during the event. Please bring cash and visit the SL Booster Club, MoBay Beignet and Frozen Amigos located at the entrance of the athletic field. Water stations will be provided for students during the relays. K-2/K-3 students will enjoy snack time before any activities get underway, so please plan to pack a snack from home. K-4 & K-5 students who will not have a guardian present to purchase a snack from the vendor should plan to bring a snack from home.

<u>Carpool/Pickup:</u> K-2 and K-3 children who do not have a guardian present will be taken to carpool for dismissal at 11:30 a.m. in front of the Japonica entrance. K-4 - 5th grade children who do not have a parent or designated child supervisor will be taken to carpool for dismissal at noon in front of the Japonica entrance.

What to Bring: Backpacks are not needed. K-2-K-4 may bring a snack or visit vendors with a parent. 1st-5th grade students need money for visiting vendors. 5th grade will need a change of clothes following tug-of-war.
