#### STEM CAMP WITH MR. MUTCHNICK: RISING 5th - 8th GRADE - JUNE 23-27

Mr. Mutchnick is hosting a STEM Camp June 23-27 on the Japonica Campus for students in **rising 5th-8<sup>th</sup> grade** from 8:00 - noon. He will be introducing physics, chemistry, and engineering in fun, creative, and exciting ways.

"We will learn how boats float and how planes fly. Not only will we learn the science behind various modes of travel, but we will design, build, and test working models: boats that float (or not!), planes that fly, hot air balloons that float, and rocket cars propelled by air. Students will learn about NASA and rocket design, leading up to their official launch date at the end of the week after they customize, build and electronically launch their own rockets to altitudes of up to 1,000 feet!! We will also perform chemistry, physics, and electricity experiments that will make your hair stand up; experiencing 50,000 volts of static electricity using a Van de Graaff generator. We'll even produce a REAL Sonic Boom...AND MUCH MORE!"
