Summer Reading 2025 Grade 6 One-Pager Assignment

- Choose one of the following books:
 - Restart by Gordan Korman
 - The Lightning Thief by Rick Riordan
 - A Long Walk to Water by Linda Sue Park
- Complete the one-pager assignment explained in the link provided.
 - Turn your work in the first full week of school.

**Please note: This linked <u>slideshow</u> contains an overview, examples, and detailed explanations of the format and requirements of the summer reading assignment.

<u>Directions:</u> Choose one of the <u>templates</u> provided or create your own. Each box will contain one of the requirements listed below (6 total, not including the title and author). The arrangement/design is all up to you! Your one-pager MUST BE DONE BY HAND - no digital versions will be accepted!

Requirements:

Title and Author: Written neatly and prominently displayed.

Quotation: Select an interesting and significant (important) quote from your book. Write it neatly and include quotation marks. Include the exact page where the quote was found, and if you choose a line of dialogue from the character, include the character's name after the quote.

Character Spotlight: Select one character from the novel. Describe that character in 3-5 sentences. Be sure to include their role or significance to the plot of the book.

Central Conflict: Explain the central conflict of the book. in 3-5 sentences. Be sure to identify what kind of conflict it is (person-to-person; person vs. society; person vs. nature/environment) in your response and explain how this conflict propelled the action of the story.

Theme: Identify a message or truth about life that readers can take away from reading this book. Explain, in 3-5 sentences, how this theme is revealed throughout the course of the book and why it is an important lesson for readers.

Illustration: Choose an important scene from the book and draw it using setting details and color. Stick-figures are okay, but use as much effort and detail as possible. Be sure to include a caption or small title to show what scene you are depicting.

Review/Personal Connection: Write a personal connection or statement of opinion about what you've read. You may create a rating system (such as 5-stars or 1-10 ranking), and you should include <u>3-5 meaningful statements</u> to show your thinking/takeaways about what you read.

Your entire page should be filled with the above elements. If you find you have extra room, repeat any of the above steps/elements or add pictures, words, quotations, or other design elements. No space should be left blank. Nothing should be left in pencil. The templates on the following pages are options, but you can create your own design as well (as long as all requirements are met)!
