#### 10th Grade, US History I

#### 11th Grade, US History II

\*Students must purchase the online version of the HMH Social Studies American History 2018 edition Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Publishing Co. It is required that each student have his/her own separate subscription. The price increased to \$24 per student, made payable to SLES, and placed in Mr. Box's mailbox in Student Services by August 1, 2023.

#### 12th Grade, AP US Government

1) The Lanahan Readings in the American Polity 7th Edition. New copies may be purchased from the school at a reduced price of \$44; checks payable to SLES must be placed in Mr. Box's mailbox in student services by August 1, 2023. (This is a new edition, so no used copies are available. Students MUST have the 7th Edition. The \$44 rate is only available through the school.)

2) The required textbook is an online edition that MUST be purchased from the school; the cost is \$44 (increase in handling fee). Checks payable to SLES must be delivered to Mr. Box's mailbox in student services no later than August 1, 2023.


