Homecoming Day Information

Parents of K2 through 5th grade students,

We are very excited about our upcoming pep rallies the week of Homecoming. **Please read the information below carefully regarding the exact location to drop off your child.** Be assured 1st-5th grade students will be dropped off in a separate location than middle and upper school students and will remain with their class while on the University Campus.

Important Information for the morning of Friday, 10/19/18:

- K2-K5 students will run a half day schedule on the Japonica campus with 11:30 am pick-up. Early morning care will be provided for K2-K5.
- **There will be no extended care** for grades K2-5th.
- 1st through 3rd grade students will be dropped off at the front entrance on University (Carpool Station B) and will remain with their class in the **Dining Hall** until we assemble in the auditorium for our pep rally.
- 4th grade through 5th grade students will be dropped off at the University Library (Carpool Station A) and will remain with their class in the **Library** until we assemble in the auditorium for our pep rally.
- Please **do not send book bags** or snacks as lunch will be provided that day by the Booster Club. For students with documented food allergies, the menu will consist of hot dogs, potato chips and water.
- In order to keep **1st through 5th grade** students in a separate location than the middle and upper school students, please enter the University Campus via the North Gate entrance and follow the signs. To enter the North Gate of the campus, you must be going southbound on University Blvd. There is not a turn lane for northbound traffic to allow you to make a left hand turn into this entrance. As you exit the campus, you must also continue southbound on University Blvd. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you!
- Middle and upper school carpool will operate normally via the South Gate entrance of the campus.
- If you have children in grades 1st-5th, drop them off first via the North Gate and then middle/upper school student(s) via the South Gate.
- We have included a map to further describe the carpool process. Signs will also be posted to direct you to the correct location.
- Once the pep rally ends, 1st-5th grade students will enjoy various activities on the University Campus. They will be with their class and homeroom teachers until dismissal at 11:00 am.
- 1st through 3rd grade students will be picked up where they were dropped off in the morning in front of the dining hall (Carpool Station B) on the University Campus at 11:00am.
- 4th grade through 5th grade students will be picked up at 11:00am in front of the University Campus Library (Carpool Station A), where they were dropped off in the morning.
- We are looking forward to a very exciting day for all of our students!
