

Reminder of the Out-of-Uniform Policy

When students are permitted to be out of uniform, the following shall apply: Casual nice jeans, khakis, capri pants, slacks, dresses, skirts, or knee-length shorts. Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be no more than 4" above the knee cap. No spaghetti straps, halter/strapless tops, or tank tops allowed. Clothing should not accentuate any particular body part or show any of the stomach. Clothing should not be frayed or have holes. No inappropriate content or wording. If a student does not adhere to the Out-of-Uniform dress code, parents may be called to bring the proper attire, and the student will be required to meet with a school administrator.
