Lower School Chapel: Tuesdays, 8:05am, St. Luke's Church on Japonica

Upper School Chapel: Wednesdays, 7:55am, the Auditorium on University

Pre-k Chapel: Thursdays (starting after Labor Day), 8:30am, Outdoor Chapel (weather permitting) on Japonica and St. Luke's Church

At the end of last year we also had the opportunity to share in Holy Eucharist with our Upper School community, and look forward to sharing this practice on a monthly basis this year. We will send further information out preceding our first Holy Eucharist of the year which is scheduled for Wednesday, September 6, at 7:55am.

This year our chapel rota includes a theme for each month. For the month of August we are reflecting on the Transfiguration, the Creation Story, Abraham, and David. As we take time to share stories on the theme, "God is doing something new," we are all invited to reflect on how we can keep our hearts and minds open to all the new things we learn this school year—staying curious and creative in all we do while loving our neighbors.
