MIDDLE SCHOOL SOCIAL STUDIES: The Social Studies Department will require online subscriptions to textbooks for Social Studies classes as indicated in the Textbook List for 2024-2025. Instead of bringing payment to the school as shown on the original textbook list, we have made the process easier for you by simply adding the cost of the online subscription to your August bill. *Parents of sixth graders* will see a charge of \$41.50. *Parents of seventh and eighth graders* will see a charge of \$26. We hope that eliminating the need for a paper check is helpful to our families!

MIDDLE SCHOOL ENGLISH & MATH: We are pleased to bring IXL into the middle school classrooms for English and math. This program will provide your student with supplemental work for these subject areas, which can be assigned online. Different activities will help retain the subject matter and track each student's progress. This will also give us insight into your students' needs so that we may help them be successful. We are very excited about this program and its enhancement of your student's education.

We would like to express our gratitude for your cooperation in this matter. We understand that managing these additional costs can be challenging, and we appreciate your understanding and support. We will collect a \$25.00 supplemental fee for Middle School Math and English, which will be added to your Blackbaud Tuition account.


UNIVERSITY CAMPUS - WILDCAT WELCOME
