



Summer Reading Camp

Who: Upcoming 4th graders

What: We will meet over the course of 5 days to work on reading comprehension skills and strategies involving students required reading of a chapter book from the list provided by 4th grade teachers. (Once I know who wants to participate we will vote to select a book that is on everyone's level to read from the list provided.) Students will be assigned some reading to do at home with questions to guide their reading, then when we meet we will reread and work on reading comprehension skills and strategies that pertain to the reading that they did at home. The last two sessions will be a combination of reviewing skills and strategies that go along with the story, as well as working on book jacket projects. Students will work on and finish their projects that will be due the first week of school for a grade, and bring materials- I will guide/ support their work. This way, students/parents will not have to stress over the project right before school starts. :) This is a great chance for students to be exposed to fourth grade level reading comprehension skills and strategies.

When: Summer break (over the course of 6 days). Sessions will be one hour long. Here are the session dates: **July 16, 17, 18, 19, 20**

Time: 4:00-5:00 p.m.

Where: Mrs. Livingston's classroom- Room #301- You may drop your child off at the 3rd grade carpool gate and pick them up there as well.

Cost: \$125 for 5 sessions- Money is due on or before sessions start and can be paid in cash or a check made out to SLES. **Money is due on or before the first session, July 16.**
